



## **Dr. Paul Khairy of the Montreal Heart Institute among the winners at the 34th edition of Concours provincial ARISTA**

Montreal, May 20, 2011 - The Montreal Heart Institute Foundation (MHIF) is extremely proud to congratulate Dr. Paul Khairy, one of seven winners announced at yesterday's gala event highlighting the 34th Concours provincial ARISTA. Some 550 people from Quebec's business community were in attendance.

This competition is aimed at recognizing and awarding the excellence of young professionals, managers, self-employed workers and entrepreneurs throughout Quebec between the ages of 18 and 40.

A winner in the "young professional from Quebec" category, Dr. Khairy's candidacy drew the attention of a jury composed of close to 50 directors from leading Quebec institutions and companies.

Dr. Paul Khairy is a cardiologist specialized in adult congenital heart disease and arrhythmia. He is a researcher at the Montreal Heart Institute, where he also serves as director of the Adult Congenital Heart Centre. In addition, Dr. Khairy holds a Canada Research Chair, and he is a professor in the faculty of medicine at the Université de Montréal. A double diploma holder from Harvard University, he is a pioneer in the treatment of arrhythmia among patients born with a heart defect.
